2011 Contest Rules

Please be on time to audition, rehearsal and show. Each contestant should bring what they need to do their act. Music needs to be "karaoke" style rendition. No live animals or firearms are allowed in any act. When auditioning, contestants should wait in the front lobby until they are escorted into the theater. Please be quiet while others are auditioning. After all the auditions, all participants will be notified if they were selected for the show or not.

Every application must be totally completed and signed by the parent or guardian for every participant who is under the age of 18. Applications must be returned to the Fortuna Rotary Club by the established deadline (July 23, 2011). Contestant may bring performance forms to the audition, dress rehearsal, or mail to the Fortuna Rotary Club at P.O. Box 729, Fortuna, CA 95540. Forms may also be faxed to the Club office at (707) 725-7984.

All contestants must be dressed and prepared prior to auditions, dress rehearsals and show. **Contestants MUST be on time.** Dress rehearsal is mandatory and all contestants are required to remain the entire time.

During the show the only time a participant may start over or repeat their performance will be when a technical problem occurs that is beyond their control as determined by the stage manager.

Contestants will remain in the dressing room except when they are being escorted to and from the stage to perform and during the awards ceremony. Adult supervision will be provided in the dressing rooms. Parents and other guests are not allowed in dressing rooms or on stage except to assist with props that are on stage prior to the dress rehearsal and the talent show.

The winning contestant will be selected by audience vote.

All rules and guidelines set forth by the Fortuna Rotary Committee must be adhered to by contestants and their parents or guardians.

No outside food or drink may be brought into the building.

The Fortuna Rotary Club is not responsible for any stolen, missing or damaged items. If any of these rules are disregarded an act will be disqualified. At any time the coordinator can disqualify a participant for reasons not stated above. All policies and rules are subject to change.
